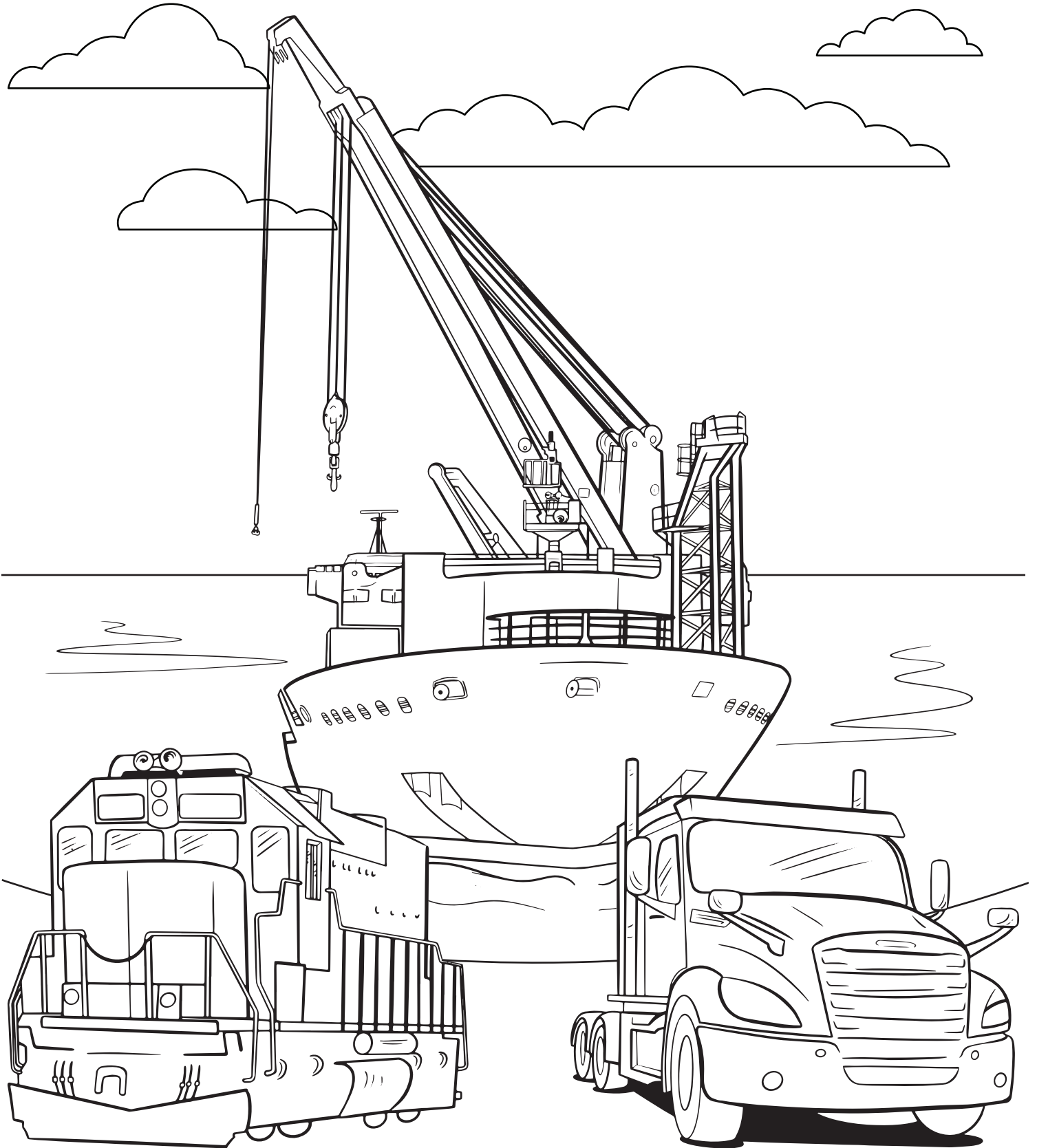


Moving cargo

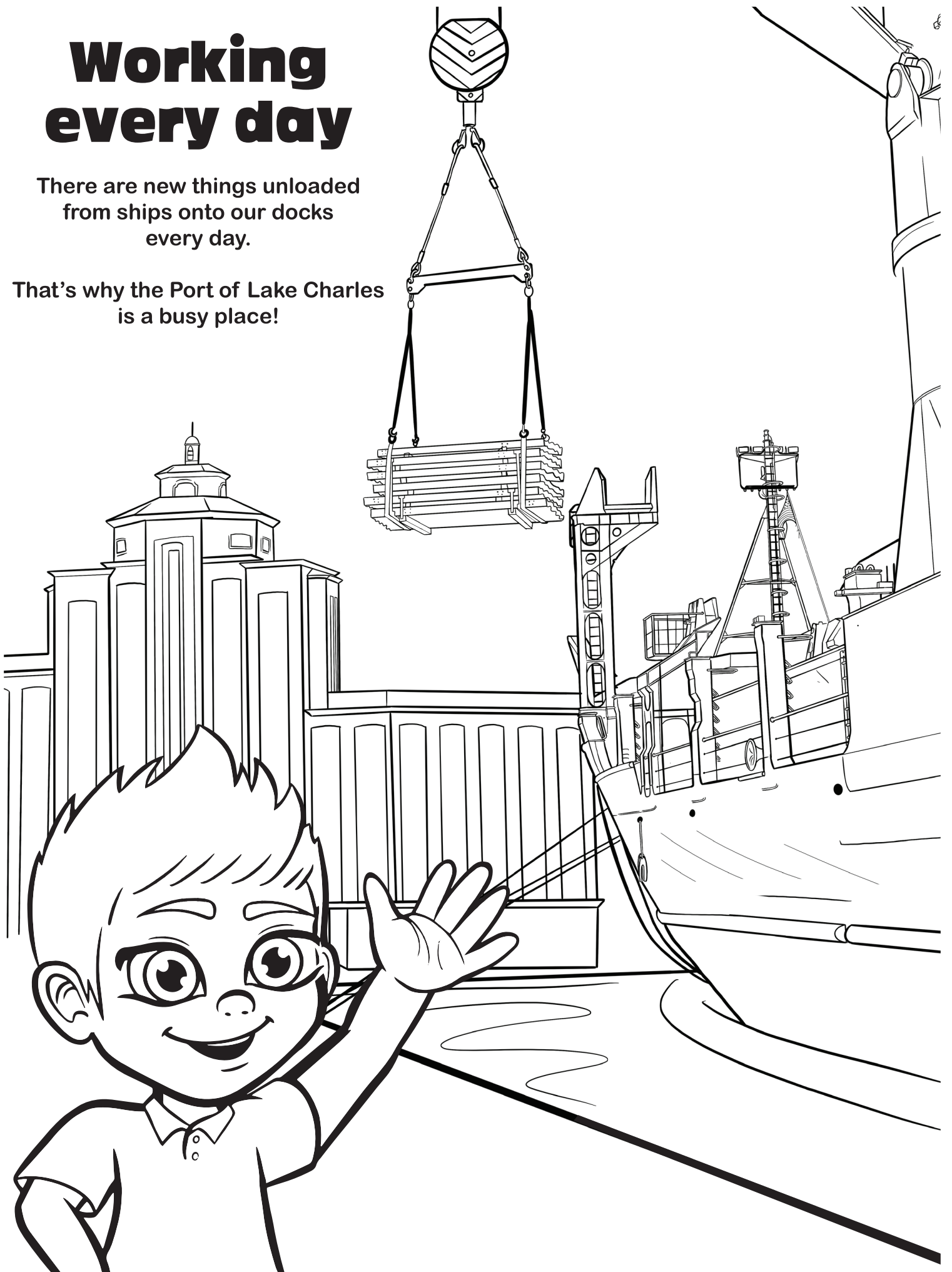
Cargo unloaded at the Port is moved around in many ways.

That's why the Port of Lake Charles is a busy place!



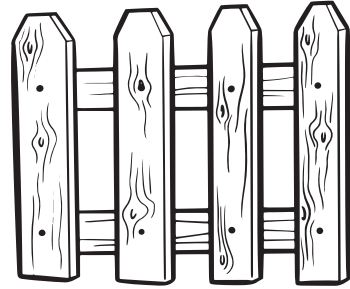
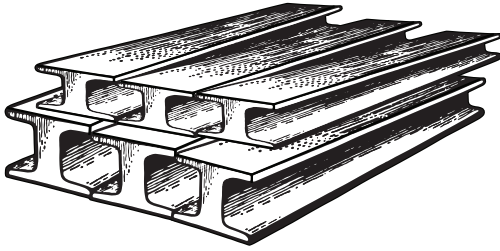
